



CEMETERY MASTER PLAN

Fulton County, Georgia



The Master Plan and zoning submittal for a new cemetery in Fulton county Georgia focused on the properties rural character as a basis for the design. Maintaining a mature pinewood knoll and meadow foreground was achieved by siting a multi-purpose chapel/mausoleum complex on the high point of the site to take advantage of its natural topography and thus accenting it as the focal point of the cemetery. From the cemetery and adjacent road patrons view the chapel being framed by mature pines over a pond and meadow foreground. This new cemetery will offer a variety of interment options including traditional ground burial, garden mausoleum interment, formal cremated remains gardens, as well as, wild-flower gardens and natural areas for cremation scattering. Also included in the Master Plan are private family mausoleums, administrative offices, a caretaker's residence, maintenance complex, entrance gatehouse, garden pavilion/committal shelter and a grass amphitheater for private and public ceremonial events.
